Course Prerequisites:

AHA Instructor Application

- Current American Heart Association certification card for that discipline. Certification cards from non-AHA programs will not be accepted (see this link for a guide to AHA certification cards).
- Current American Heart Association Heartsaver Adult, Child, Infant CPR & First Aid provider certification card (2020 guidelines). An ASHI (American Safety and Health Institute) does not meet this requirement.
- Complete the AHA instructor Essentials Online training for that discipline.
- Alignment with an AHA Training Center or Training Site: Instructors are required to join the AHA ATLAS (use this link) and request alignment with an AHA Training Center. Instructors will have their alignment approved after completing their Instructor Course requirements. Angelmedic CPR welcomes those who attend our Instructor Course to align with us. Instructors not aligning with Angelmedic CPR will need to complete their course monitoring and have their Instructor certification card issued by the Training Center they will be aligned with. Please free to contact us for more information.
- Passing score (84%) on the exam/ essential course for that discipline.

The final part of Instructor training consists of the candidate teaching a portion of class per discipline (conducted at Angelmedic CPR primary location) under the supervision of

a Angelmedic CPR faculty member. After successfully completing this portion, the candidate will be issued a Instructor certification card. Candidates must enroll in a scheduled Course Monitoring Class in their discipline within 6 months of their instructor course. If the candidate does not complete the course monitoring session within 6 months of completing the instructor training, the instructor course must be taken again.

Your first year to align with Angelmedic CPR is free. After that your annual alignment Fee is \$150.00. Services we provide to you (see below).

- Scheduling Instructor Renewal classes to meet demand.
- Fielding daily phone calls to assist your students with claiming their certification cards, accessing their certification cards, changing any incorrect names or email addresses in their accounts, and helping out with technical issues.
- Reviewing your Portal Orders for accuracy and processing your certification cards through the AHA Instructor Network.
- Developing and maintaining software to process your Portal Orders.
- Keeping the Instructor Portal up to date with relevant documents. Retaining all your instructor records as required by the AHA.
- Updating instructor renewal curriculum to reflect changes in science and AHA policy.
- Tracking instructor certification expiration and following up with expiring instructors to help them renew.
